Job Description:

Administer and maintain the spatial database infrastructure of the NJ Highlands Council GIS data. Work with the Office of Information Technology and Consultants to update and maintain Highlands public data and interactive mapping applications. Work with Highlands staff to conduct spatial analysis, and provide cartographic and analytical deliverables for planning and science purposes.

Duties:

- Maintain geospatial architecture (ArcGIS Online, Open Data & ArcGIS Server administration, and PostgreSQL).
- Follow GIS projects through their entire lifecycle, from requirements gathering, choosing the technical platform, implementation, and presenting the results.
- Creates workflows to update RMP era data by interpreting technical reports and gathering historical information from other staff.
- Perform spatial analysis and create cartographic deliverables
- Coordinate with the NJ Office of Information Technology to deliver data updates for use in ArcGIS online, Open Data and web mapping applications.
- Maintenance on web mapping applications for the Highlands allowing the internal management of the systems and working with outside contractor to keep applications running optimally.
- Use python and SQL to stream line data processing.
- Updates and produces data to inform preservation priorities within the region.
- Train on GIS software and tools. Produce documentation and training materials.
