**NUMBER OF VACANCIES:** Three (3)

<u>DUTIES</u>: Under direction of a supervisory official in a State department or agency, or in a local government jurisdiction, develops, provides and oversees technical training programs in compliance with Federal rules and regulations; functions as a subject matter expert and provides technical information and instruction to emergency response personnel and assists them in their response efforts; responds to and investigates incidents involving hazardous materials, weapons of mass destruction (WMD) and/or pandemic disaster; performs other related duties as required.

## **REQUIREMENTS**

**EDUCATION:** Graduation from an accredited college or university with a bachelor's degree.

**EXPERIENCE:** Three (3) years of professional and/or technical experience involving emergency response including CBRNE (Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear, and Explosives), disaster response to include pandemics, and/or weapons of mass destruction (WMD).

<u>NOTE:</u> Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

**LICENSE:** Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

**RESUME NOTE:** Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in the resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so will result in your ineligibility.
