REQUIREMENTS

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

ADVANCEMENT: Applicants who successfully complete the six (6) month training period will be eligible for promotion to the title of Agency Services Representative 1 in accordance with Civil Service Commission procedures. *The inability of an employee in a trainee title to successfully attain a level of performance warranting advancement shall be considered cause for separation.*

PREFERENCE: Preference will be given to applicants who are able to read, write, speak, understand, or communicate in Spanish and English sufficiently to perform the duties of this position. Please indicate your bilingual abilities in Spanish and English in the cover letter or email when applying.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in your ineligibility.
