Routine reporting of STD case data to CDC and conduct routine data cleaning to ensure the best possible data are available for analysis and evaluation moving the Division to better data practices. Create reports, dashboards, and visualizations to communicate findings; apply best practices in data visualization design & continuously improve upon intuitive user experience for internal and external stakeholders. Resume Note:
