Description:

Under direction of the Director, Office of Fiscal and Data Services, performs education research by collecting, analyzing, and interpreting statistical data in order to meet changing education needs; develops educational programming by conducting analyses and evaluation of educational programs, surveys, needs assessment, and related research; establishes, maintains, and evaluates program and fiscal data related to state and federal formula aid and discretionary grant applications and allocations; performs mandated regulatory functions; is knowledgeable in and works with independence in areas of assignment; and performs other related work as required.

Coordinates the New Jersey Department of Education's efforts to fulfill the federal reporting requirements of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) as the Department's designated IDEA Part B Data Manager; manages cross-office work groups to ensure the timely, accurate, and high quality submission of New Jersey's special education related data; builds data literacy and capacity across the Department and in the field through presentations, memos that clearly and succinctly summarize the most relevant and actionable analytic findings, and data visualization tools and techniques; and supports efforts to evaluate special education programs to improve outcomes for children with disabilities.

Requirements:

Education: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Master's degree in Public Administration, Educational Statistics and Measurement, Statistics, or a related field.

Experience: Three (3) years of experience in program evaluation, statistical analysis, or psychometrics.

Preferred Education/Experience: A solid understanding of data sources, data organization, and storage, including experience as part of a data governance team or as a data steward; experience managing and submitting federal reports; designing, implementing, analyzing, and summarizing implementation of educational interventions to improve outcomes; strong knowledge of and experience with reporting and statistical software (such as STATA or R); and experience with data visualization software (such as Tableau or Power BI) and in creating data dashboards.

Open to the Following:
