## NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE: One (1)

<u>DUTIES:</u> Under the general supervision of the Executive Director in the Division of Violence Intervention and Victim Assistance (VIVA), creates and cultivates relationships between community partners/stakeholders and VIVA; collaborates across VIVA offices to determine and prioritize community engagement strategies; coordinates community engagement initiatives from conceptualization to implementation; plans, coordinates and leads meetings and workshops; supports the network of community partners in working towards shared goal of a safer, more resilient New Jersey; provides communication support including drafting website content, social media content, e-newsletters, and other communications; tracks, monitors and assesses the impact of community engagement strategies; serves as the liaison between internal and external stakeholder groups; does other related work.

## REQUIREMENTS

**EDUCATION:** Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

**EXPERIENCE:** Three (3) years of experience in planning, monitoring, coordinating, implementing, modifying and/or evaluating agency programs and services.

**NOTE:** Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated on a year-for-year basis.

**NOTE:** A Master's degree from an accredited college or university in a discipline appropriate to the position may be substituted for one (1) year of experience.

**LICENSE:** Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey.

**PREFERENCE:** Preference will be given to candidates with minimum of 5 years of community leadership experience, having worked with nonprofit, human services, or governmental organizations. Experience working in the fields of anti-violence, social justice, victims'/survivors' rights, trauma-informed services, community organizing, community relations, and/or constituent services are also preferred.

**RESUME NOTE:** Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
