NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE: One (1)

<u>DUTIES</u>: Under supervision of a supervisory official in a state department or agency, as directed reviews and analyzes departmental administration, objectives, efficiency and effectiveness, and supervises programs and activities as assigned; does other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

<u>NOTE</u>: Applicants must meet one of the following or a combination of both experience and education. Thirty (30) semester hour credits are equal to one (1) year of relevant experience.

Seven (7) years of experience in organization, staffing, or systems analysis.

<u>OR</u>

Possession of a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university; and three (3) years of the abovementioned professional experience.

<u>NOTE</u>: "Professional experience" refers to work that is creative, analytical, evaluative, and interpretive; requires a range and depth of specialized knowledge of the profession's principles, concepts, theories, and practices; and is performed with the authority to act according to one's own judgment and make accurate and informed decisions.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

<u>RESUME NOTE</u>: Eligibility determinations for experience and education will be based upon the resume and unofficial transcripts submitted at the time of application. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide a CSC approved evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency, with a course-by-course breakdown, prior to the closing date (see <u>CSC foreign degree information</u>). Failure to do so may result in disqualification of your education towards eligibility.

All offers of employment are conditional subject to the applicant agreeing to and then passing a background check that may include fingerprinting.
