GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The Clinical Psychiatrist is responsible for providing and overseeing the treatment of patients assigned to a 25-bed forensic inpatient unit, in addition to coverage of other units as needed. The psychiatrist admits patients to the hospital and actively participates in discharge planning and related documentation. Responsible for prescribing medications in consultation with other treatment team members, including the physician specialist and consultants, and makes application for involuntary psychiatric treatment when needed. Will participate in interdisciplinary treatment team meetings and advises other team members on the patient's psychiatric needs. The psychiatrist completes psychiatric evaluations, reviews/assesses risk, contributes to SSPRC packets, testifies as to clinical recommendations in court proceedings and at hearings in pursuit of treatment over objection. Will ensure adherence to the Joint Commission, regulatory, and professional standards of care. Clinical Psychiatrists may be assigned workgroups/committees as designated by the CEO and Medical Director. The Clinical Psychiatrist may also be assigned MOD coverage.

Note: As per Executive Order 325, the State of New Jersey is requiring all employees to be fully vaccinated. To comply with that requirement, employees must provide proof of vaccination status. Please do not submit proof of vaccination at this time; instructions will be provided if an offer of employment results from this Notice of Vacancy.

REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

CERTIFICATION: Possession of current certification as a diplomate in the specialty of psychiatry issued by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology.

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of clinical experience in the practice of Psychiatry subsequent to Board Certification.

NOTE: A sub-specialty board certification in Addictions, Geriatrics, or Forensics may be substituted for one (1) year of experience.

NOTE: A sub-specialty board certification in Child or Adolescent may be substituted for two (2) years of experience.

LICENSE: Possession of an Unrestricted License to practice medicine in the State of New Jersey.

Possession of an unrestricted State of New Jersey Controlled Dangerous Substances License.

Possession of an unrestricted Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) Registration number.

Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
