GENERAL DESCRIPTION			
<p>The Special Treatment Unit is a 500-bed secured forensic facility located in Avenel, NJ. The STU population consists primarily of adult males. Our inpatient units are designed to treat adults who have been civilly committed under the NJ Sexually Violent Predator's Act. The cognitive level varies with IQs ranging from 48 to 137. A small portion of our population have traditional Axis I psychiatric diagnoses, but many suffer from personality disorders. In support of Education services, the Special Treatment Unit is in need of certified Teachers to teach Adult Basic skills, K-8, and support GED/TASC learning. The best individual for these needs would have several years of experience as a certified teacher, flexibility, experience with various education levels and confidence within skill set to support appropriate boundaries during instruction within a secure environment</p>
