DESCRIPTION OF THE SPECIFIC POSITION: As the Director of the Office of Emergency Telecommunications Services, shall serve as the State 9-1-1 Director. The individual shall direct the implementation of a cost-effective statewide Next Generation 9-1-1 (NG9-1-1) Network based on the NENA i3 standards serving nearly 200 PSAPs. Oversees the development and technical design of system enhancements; development and revisions of governing regulations and operational and training standards of the system for Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) and Public Safety Dispatch Point (PSDP) call-takers and dispatchers and other public safety personnel. Must have experience in working within a governmental environment and a willingness to promote shared services/consolidation. Must have in-depth knowledge of FCC requirements related to wireless, wireline, VoIP and texting to 9-1-1. Must have knowledge of and experience in Public Safety Land Mobile Radio (LMR) communications including conventional and trunked systems and familiarity with the National Emergency Communications Plan (NECP).

DEFINITION: Under the direction of the Chief Technology Officer, direct the work of the Office of Emergency Telecommunications Services which is responsible for providing services surrounding all State 9-1-1 telecommunications systems and Public Safety Interoperable Communications.

REQUIREMENTS:

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a bachelor's degree is preferred. Certification as an ENP is an advantage.

EXPERIENCE: Seven (7) years of experience in a public safety agency managing an Information Technology environment or a related field, which shall involve directing the administration/implementation of programs, coordinating activities across agencies, devising improvement plans for a unit, and/or promoting the development of agency services.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

FOR NON-U.S. CITIZENS AND/OR FOREIGN DEGREES

AUTHORIZATION TO WORK: U.S. Citizenship is not required. Selected candidate must be authorized to work in the U.S. according to Department of Homeland Security, U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services regulations.
