**<u>DUTIES</u>**: Under limited supervision of a Supervising Investigator or under the guidance of an Investigator 4 or other supervisory official in the Department of Law and Public Safety, performs regulatory audits and inspections of licensed premises; reviews records, files, financial statements, and other transactions to determine compliance with rules or regulations governing consumer protection laws; conducts, under guidance of a team leader, civil and regulatory investigative activities or specialized investigations to detect alleged noncompliance with or violations of New Jersey state statutes, administrative codes, or Professional Rules of Conduct or consumer protection laws; performs other related duties required. ## **REQUIREMENTS**

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college with a Bachelor's degree.

**EXPERIENCE:** Two (2) years of experience in the conduct of civil or criminal investigations related to compliance, enforcement, detection, and surveillance activity including the preparation of investigative reports; OR two (2) years of experience in the conduct of investigative administrative audits and/or regulatory examinations of records maintained by businesses and organizations; OR two (2) years of experience in the conduct of investigations for the government, the military, consumer protection programs, public advocacy organizations, or the public interest.

Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute experience as indicated on a year-for-year basis.

Completion of a supervised internship field placement of 300 hours in an undergraduate curriculum in Criminal Justice or a related degree program may be substituted for one (1) year of the non-supervisory experience.

A Juris Doctorate degree or a Master's Degree in Criminal Justice, Public Administration, Business Administration, Law, or other related field may be substituted for one (1) year of the non-supervisory experience.

**LICENSE:** Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

**<u>PREFERENCE</u>**: Preference will be given to candidates with using appropriate software programs to develop queries and prepare reports that clearly and accurately summarize data and provide written and/or demonstrative analytical work products to investigative teams.

**<u>RESUME NOTE</u>**: Eligibility determinations are based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date.
