Description:

Under direction of the Director, Office of School Bus Safety, assists in developing short and long-term education and/or financial plans; assists in conducting analyses and evaluations of curricula and other education programs, surveys, needs assessments, and related research; assists in the establishment, maintenance, and evaluation of program and fiscal data related to state and federal aid, grant applications, and allocations; performs mandated regulatory functions; works with some independence in areas of assignments; assists in the oversight of the school busing industry to ensure adherence to federal and State laws; coordinates with other agencies to maintain accountability among school bus drivers and school bus contractors; performs other related duties.

Additional job duties may include: Establishing policies and procedures for determining if a school bus contractor should be temporarily debarred from submitting bids on student transportation contracts; evaluating pertinent information to make a recommendation regarding debarring a school bus contractor; maintaining listing school bus contractors that have been debarred; reviewing information submitted to the Department related to potential school bus drivers' criminal history; obtaining statements of assurance from school districts and school bus contractors; reviewing statements submitted by a board of education or school bus contractor verifying that a school bus driver whose driver's license has been suspended or revoked is no longer operating a school bus for the board of education or school bus contractor; coordinating with the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission and the Department of Law and Public Safety on the sharing of information on matters related to school bus safety; proposing regulatory changes related to school bus safety; preparing an annual report for the Commissioner of Education detailing the office's activities in the prior year.

Requirements:

Education: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Master's degree in Education or related field.

Note: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of college. Applicants wishing to substitute additional experience for the required master's degree, must possess a total of six (6) years of combined education and experience, in addition to the required experience cited above.

Experience: Three (3) years of experience in education administration, planning, research, program evaluation, or finance.

Preferred Experience: Previous experience related to student transportation in a state agency or school district; experience ensuring compliance with a statutory or regulatory framework; experience with writing and

establishing policies and procedures; writing annual reports for legislative bodies; collaboration with multiple stakeholders and partners to share sensitive information; or, familiarity with New Jersey State Law and New Jersey Department of Education administrative code related to student transportation.

Open to the Following: In accordance with the New Jersey First Act P.L. 2011 c.70, effective September 1, 2011, new public employees are required to obtain New Jersey residency within one (1) year of employment.
