<u>DUTIES</u>: Under the direction of a Cook, Head Cook, Food Service Supervisor or other supervisory official in the Juvenile Justice Commission, assists with the work involved in food preparation and service, and may take the lead in a group of Food Service Workers, or youth engaged in storing and preparing food for cooking and in serving food; transports prepared meals; does related work as required. REQUIREMENTS

EXPERIENCE: One (1) year of experience in general unskilled kitchen or food service work.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in your ineligibility.
