Description:

Under the close supervision of a supervisor in the Student Protection Unit of the Office of Fiscal Accountability and Compliance, as a trainee and productive worker, learns to perform routine office and/or field duties to investigate alleged non-compliance with State statutes and regulatory requirements. The Investigator Trainee will conduct criminal history record checks of applicants for positions in New Jersey's public schools, private schools for students with disabilities, charter schools, non-public schools, and authorized private vendors; reviews criminal history records to disqualify or render ineligible those individuals with convictions or charges pending for certain crimes and offenses; and does other related duties as required.

Requirements:

Education: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

Advancement: Appointees who successfully complete the twelve (12) month training period will be eligible for advancement to the title of Investigator 1, in accordance with the New Jersey Civil Service Commission procedures. The inability of an employee in this trainee title to attain a level of performance warranting advancement to the title listed above shall be considered as cause for separation.

Note: Applicants must submit a copy of their final unofficial transcripts, which indicates the date a degree was conferred, and the type of degree conferred. Failure to submit final unofficial transcripts may result in disqualification from consideration.

Open to the Following:

In accordance with the New Jersey First Act P.L. 2011 c.70, effective September 1, 2011, new public employees are required to obtain New Jersey residency within one (1) year of employment. Applicants must meet the open competitive requirements listed on the job specification on file at the Civil Service Commission.
