GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Under direction of a Director or other official in a state department, is responsible for the executive management of staff, treatment programs, and administrative operations of a care facility; does other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Five (5) years of administrative experience in the management of a care facility for the aged, mentally ill, developmentally disabled, and/or troubled adolescent children, three (3) years of which shall have included direct supervision of a major hospital, institution, or adolescent care unit or program.

NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

NOTE: A Master's degree in Public Administration, Hospital Administration, Social Work, Psychology, Nursing, or other related field may be substituted for one (1) year of required administrative experience.

SPECIAL NOTE: If appointed to a position located in a Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs facility, appointees must possess a valid Nursing Home Administrator License issued by the State of New Jersey.
