<u>DUTIES</u>: Under the close supervision of a Research Data Supervisor or other supervisory official in the Department of Law and Public Safety, performs basic research, collects data, schedules report maintenance, and does statistical work in one or more programmatic or investigative areas, utilizing structured and unstructured data from existing reports and resources for statewide business improvement; does all related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree including or supplemented by 18 credits in social sciences, criminal justice, statistics, or a closely related field.

EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of experience in collecting, analyzing, reporting, and disseminating large volumes of data using statistical techniques to identify trends or patterns in complex data for research projects.

<u>NOTE</u>: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute the specialized eighteen (18) credits for the remaining education outlined above on a year-for-year basis.

<u>NOTE</u>: A Master's degree in Public Administration, Business Administration, Economics, Finance, or Accounting may be substituted for one (1) year of indicated experience.

NOTE: A Ph.D. in social sciences, criminal justice, statistics, or a closely related field may be substituted for the two (2) years of required experience.

SPECIAL NOTE: Special Services positions are filled on a part-time, temporary basis during normal business hours. Candidates appointed to a Special Services title will be limited to 944 work hours in a fiscal year.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey.

<u>RESUME NOTE</u>: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
