GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Under the general supervision of a Research Scientist 1, this position oversees the design, development and implementation of an integrated training and exercise program within the Department of Health to sustain and build public health capabilities to prepare for, respond to, and recovery from emergencies. This position is responsible for the design, conduct, and evaluation of exercises utilizing a building-block approach in accordance with established Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation (HSEEP). This position will also lead the development and administration of a comprehensive training program that is compliant with the current federal grant requirements, and established State regulations, standards, directives, and policies and procedures. This position serves as subject matter expert and will work in coordination with our state partners to complete required assessments, including but not limited, to the Threat, Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment (THIRA), Integrated Preparedness Plan, and Hazard and Vulnerability Assessments. This position staffs the State Emergency Operations Center, Emergency Support Function 8 desk when activated by NJ Office of Emergency Management.

REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Master's degree in a discipline appropriate to the position.

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of full-time experience in a field appropriate to the position.

NOTE: A Doctorate in a discipline appropriate to the position may be substituted for two (2) years of experience indicated above.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a valid driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essentials duties of the position.
