<u>DUTIES</u>: Under direction of the Port Security Section Commander, performs confidential legislative, legal, compliance, adjudication, and policy-influencing research and administration in conformance with Title 53, as it relates to the New Jersey State Police Port Security Section

("Section"). Shall also act as liaison between various State Police Units both within and outside of the Port Security Section, NJ Office of the Attorney General, NJ Department of Law, NJ Office of Administrative Law, International Longshoremen's Association, and outside law enforcement agencies.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of experience involving legal or legislative research, drafting of rules, regulations, legislation, amendments, and/or the interpretation of statutes.

NOTE: Appointees currently matriculating in an accredited law school as an LL.B or J.D. candidate may substitute such enrollment for the three (3) years of required experience on a year-for-year basis.

NOTE: The legal specialist may be a fulltime law school student working for the state on a limited parttime basis or during periods when law school is not in session.

<u>LICENSE:</u> Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in the resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so will result in your ineligibility.
