## **GENERAL DESCRIPTION**

Under the administrative direction of the Chief Executive Officer at Trenton psychiatric hospital, organizes, develops, and directs systematic administrative support services and/or clinical services to ensure that division, institution, and accrediting standards are maintained. In the absence of the Chief Executive Officer, may assume the duties of planning, directing, and coordinating all hospital or facility activities to maintain full patient care in accordance with accepted standards; manages staff and work activities; prepares and signs official performance evaluations for subordinate staff; does related duties as required.

NOTE: As per Executive Order 325, the State of New Jersey is requiring all employees to be fully vaccinated. To comply with that requirement, employees must provide proof of vaccination status. Please do not submit proof of vaccination at this time; instructions will be provided if an offer of employment results from this Notice of Vacancy.

# REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Master's degree in Hospital Administration, Public Administration, Public Health, Business Administration or Mental Health Administration, Psychology, Social Work, Nursing, Rehabilitation, or related field.

EXPERIENCE: Five (5) years of administrative experience managing a significant service of program in a psychiatric or general hospital, large mental health facility, or social services agency dealing with the mentally ill.

NOTE: Applicants who do not possess a Master's degree may substitute one (1) year of additional experience as indicated above.

NOTE: In the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, appointees may be required to possess a valid nursing license issued by the State of New Jersey.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
